Submitted papers must be unpublished and should not be submitted elsewhere at the same time. Papers must have from **4 to 6 full pages** according IEEE Conference Manuscript Standard. All submitted papers will be peer reviewed by at least three independent reviewers.

The official Conference language is **English**. No simultaneous translation will be provided. All materials concerning the IEEE UKRCON-2019 should be written in English. Conference Proceedings will be submitted for inclusion in **IEEE Xplore Digital Library**. “No-show” papers won’t be submitted for inclusion in IEEE Xplore Digital Library. Each author can submit and present **no more than 3 papers**.
